## THINGS TO TRY

Making small changes in the office, workspace or studio can add up to a big win - why not try:

- Providing communal recycling bins rather than individual desk bins
- Using reusable mugs/refill bottles instead of plastic or disposable ones
- Asking for deliveries to be zero plastic and/or minimum packaging
- Supplying easily accessible composting containers
- Appointing a company volunteer to be your Environmental Champion
- Promoting the 3Ps - pee, poo, and paper should be the only things flushed down the loo.

## LONG TERM

Create a Plastics Policy to review your use across all departments and research ways to lessen or avoid using single-use plastic.

Educate your employees on the waste principles of refuse/reduce/reuse/recycle, and help them adopt it.

Reward employees for supporting changes - you could even set up a Plastic Champion scheme or support them to volunteer with us.
